



LOTTO 6/49 GAME CONDITIONS AND PRIZE STRUCTURE STATEMENT

1. RULES AND REGULATIONS

LOTTO 6/49 is governed by the Rules and Regulations Respecting Lotteries and Lottery Tickets of Interprovincial Lottery Corporation ("ILC") which are available upon request and WHICH INCLUDE LIMITATIONS OF LIABILITY.

2. ISSUANCE OF TICKETS

Upon payment of \$2 for each 6-number selection per draw to an authorized retailer by any eligible person, a ticket will be issued showing the draw date(s), the 6-number selection(s) chosen by that person or by computer, the amount wagered, the control number(s) and other relevant information.

3. DRAW

On each draw date, or as soon as possible thereafter, ILC will cause six main numbers and one bonus number (being seven different numbers) to be drawn at random from among all numbers from 1 to 49.

4. WINNING SELECTIONS

Winning Selections as a result of any draw are determined as follows:

<u>WINNING SELECTION</u>	<u>CONSISTS OF</u>
6/6	the six main numbers
5/6+	any five main numbers and the bonus number
5/6	any five main numbers and one other number*
4/6	any four main numbers and two other numbers* OR any four main numbers, the bonus number and one other number*
3/6	any three main numbers and three other numbers* OR any three main numbers, the bonus number and two other numbers*
2/6+	any two main numbers, the bonus number and three other numbers*

* "other number" means any number which has not been drawn.

5. WINNING TICKETS

Any valid ticket for any draw bearing any Winning Selection of such draw is a Winning Ticket and entitles its holder(s) to claim, for each such Winning Selection, a prize calculated in accordance with Section 6 hereof.

6. PRIZES

After each draw, ILC allocates for the payment of prizes 47% of all amounts wagered for that draw (the "Prize Fund") and a Pools Fund is determined by deducting from the Prize Fund an amount equal to the total amount payable as prizes on the 3/6 Winning Selections and 2/6+ Winning Selections. Subject to Sections 7 and 8, prizes are determined as follows:

<u>WINNING SELECTION</u>	<u>POOL</u>	<u>PRIZE</u>
6/6	80.5% of the Pools Fund ⁽¹⁾⁽⁴⁾	Share of Pool ⁽³⁾
5/6+	5.75% of the Pools Fund	Share of Pool ⁽³⁾
5/6	4.75% of the Pools Fund	Share of Pool ⁽³⁾
4/6	9% of the Pools Fund ⁽²⁾	Share of Pool ⁽³⁾
3/6	Fixed	\$10
2/6+	Fixed	\$5



- (1) If there was no 6/6 Winning Selection in the last preceding draw, the 6/6 Pool is increased by the amount of the 6/6 Pool of such last preceding draw and, if there was no 5/6+ Winning Selection in the last preceding draw, the 6/6 Pool is increased by the amount of the 5/6+ Pool of such last preceding draw (the "Rollover") which Rollover shall not take into account any guarantee which ILC may have given as to the amount of the 6/6 Pool of such last preceding draw.
- (2) If there is no 5/6 Winning Selection, the 4/6 Pool is increased by the amount of the 5/6 Pool.
- (3) "Share of Pool" means, with reference to any category of Winning Selections, an amount calculated by dividing the dollar amount of that category's Pool by the number of Winning Selections in that category.
- (4) If and when ILC has guaranteed the amount of the 6/6 Pool, then the amount of the 6/6 Pool shall be the greater of (a) the aggregate of 80.5% of the Pools Fund and the Rollover (the "6/6 Regular Pool") and (b) the amount so guaranteed.

7. POOL PERCENTAGE CHANGES

If the Rollover exceeds \$30 million, then the percentages of the Pools Fund applying to the 6/6, 5/6+, 5/6 and 4/6 Pools as provided in Section 6 shall be changed to 40%, 16%, 15% and 29%, respectively.

This Section 7 shall not apply if and when ILC has guaranteed the amount of the 6/6 Pool.

8. PRIZE CALCULATION

The amount of each prize is calculated by dividing the dollar amount of each category's Pool by the number of Winning Selections in that category provided that (a) for 6/6 Prizes, cents are increased to the next dollar (e.g. \$8,075,487.17 is rounded up to \$8,075,488.00) and (b) for 5/6+, 5/6 and 4/6 Prizes, cents under \$0.08 are reduced to \$0.00 (e.g. \$2,726.37 is rounded down to \$2,726.30) and cents \$0.08 and over are increased to \$0.10 (e.g. \$2,726.38 is rounded up to \$2,726.40).

9. PRIZE CLAIMS

Prizes must be claimed within one year following the draw date in the manner stated on the back of the ticket.

10. ODDS OF WINNING

The approximate odds of winning for a single selection are as follows:

6/6	One in	13,983,816
5/6+	One in	2,330,636
5/6	One in	55,492
4/6	One in	1,033
3/6	One in	56.7
2/6+	One in	81.2
Any prize	One in	32.3

ADVANCE PLAY CONDITIONS

The above Game Conditions and Prize Structure Statement was approved by the Interprovincial Lottery Corporation. Western Canada Lottery Corporation ("WCLC") offers Advance Play for Lotto 6/49 in its jurisdiction. The following conditions have been approved by WCLC and apply to Advance Play:

11. ADVANCE PLAY

By paying the appropriate amount, the same numbers selected for a draw can be played by Selection Slip or Quick Pick for up to 24 consecutive draws.



12. ISSUANCE OF SUBSTITUTE TICKET

If a ticket becomes a Winning Ticket and is eligible for additional draws following the draw date for which it is produced to win a prize, the prize will be paid and a substitute or replacement ticket will be issued for the remaining outstanding draw dates for which it is eligible and the ticket originally produced will, upon issuance of such substitute or replacement ticket, become void.

13. ALTERNATE PRIZE CLAIMS FOR ADVANCE PLAY

In the case of Advance Play, prizes must be claimed in the manner stated on the back of the ticket within one year following each draw date for which the ticket is eligible to win a prize.

14. EFFECTIVE DATE

The LOTTO 6/49 Game Conditions and Prize Structure Statement described herein take effect May 13, 2005.
