



PAYDAY GAME CONDITIONS AND PRIZE STRUCTURE STATEMENT

1. RULES AND REGULATIONS

PAYDAY is governed by the Rules and Regulations Respecting Lotteries and Gaming of Western Canada Lottery Corporation (WCLC) WHICH INCLUDE LIMITATIONS OF LIABILITY AND ARE AVAILABLE FROM WCLC UPON REQUEST.

2. PLAY

Each play is comprised of 15 selections of 4 numbers each.

3. ISSUANCE OF TICKETS

To participate, any eligible person must present a completed PAYDAY selection slip or request a Quick Pick ticket and pay the authorized retailer \$2 for each play per draw. For each play, the first selection will be issued based on a selection slip or Quick Pick, as the case may be, and will be eligible for the "\$1,000 A Week For Life" prize category. 14 additional computer-generated selections will also then be issued for each play as follows: 2 selections eligible for the \$50,000 prize category; 4 selections eligible for the \$20,000 prize category; and 8 selections eligible for the \$1,000 prize category. A ticket will then be issued showing the draw date(s), the selections for each prize category for each play, the amount wagered, the control number(s) and other relevant information. **Note:** Each distinct horizontal line of four numbers located completely to the right or completely to the left of the center vertical line(s) on a PAYDAY ticket is a selection.

4. DRAW

On each draw date, or as soon as possible thereafter, WCLC will cause four numbers to be drawn at random from among the 77 natural numbers from 01 to 77 inclusive.

5. WINNING SELECTIONS

A participating PAYDAY selection on a ticket is a Winning Selection if, when compared to the four PAYDAY numbers drawn on the corresponding draw date, it matches:

<u>WINNING SELECTION</u>	<u>CONSISTS OF</u>
Match 4/4	An exact match of four of the four numbers drawn
Match 3/4	An exact match of three of the four numbers drawn
Match 2/4	An exact match of two of the four numbers drawn

6. WINNING TICKETS

Any valid ticket for any draw bearing any Winning Selection of such draw is a Winning Ticket and entitles its holder(s) to claim, for each such Winning Selection, a prize calculated in accordance with Section 8 hereof. Only one prize per Winning Selection may be claimed.

7. ADVANCE PLAY

By paying the appropriate amount, the same numbers selected for a draw can be played by selection slip or Quick Pick for up to 24 additional consecutive draws. If a ticket becomes a Winning Ticket on a PAYDAY draw and the ticket is eligible for additional draws following the draw date for which it is eligible to win a PAYDAY prize, the prize will be paid and a Replacement Ticket bearing the same selections as the original ticket will be issued for the remaining outstanding draws for which the original ticket is eligible. Upon such Replacement Ticket being issued, the original ticket is void.



8. PRIZES

8.1 Prizes are determined as follows:

<u>WINNING SELECTION</u>	<u>PRIZE CATEGORY</u>	<u>PRIZE</u>
Match 4/4	\$1,000 A Week For Life	\$1,000 A Week For Life annuity* -OR- \$675,000*
Match 4/4	\$50,000	\$50,000
Match 4/4	\$20,000	\$20,000
Match 4/4	\$1,000	\$1,000
Match 3/4	Any Prize Category	\$25
Match 2/4	Any Prize Category	\$2

*Subject to the restrictions outlined in Sections 8.2 to 8.3 hereof inclusive.

8.2 Annuity prizes are subject to Section 8.3 and are also subject to the Special Game Conditions Governing Annuity Prizes of WCLC as amended from time to time, a current copy of which follows as Schedule "A" hereto.

8.3 For each draw, if there are five or more Match 4/4 Winning Selections for the \$1,000 A Week For Life prize category, the annuity prizes and the single cash payment prizes of \$675,000 will not be available, and each prize in that prize category will be paid as a single cash payment determined by dividing \$2,700,000 by the number of Match 4/4 Winning Selections for that prize category for that draw.

9. PRIZE CLAIMS

Prizes must be claimed in the manner stated on the back of the ticket within one year following the draw date for the applicable Winning Selection.

10. AMENDMENTS

WCLC may from time to time amend these PAYDAY Game Conditions and Prize Structure Statement and the Special Game Conditions Governing Annuity Prizes of WCLC.

11. EFFECTIVE DATE

The PAYDAY Game Conditions and Prize Structure Statement described herein take effect on March 30, 2007.
