If the player's Spin Win prize is a "Big Spin", they win \$10,000 PLUS a chance to spin a prize wheel that guarantees them at least another \$100,000, and possibly up to \$500,000!

Tickets for THE BIG SPIN are available at Lotto Spot retailers throughout the province.
