BIG CHANGES COMING TO LOTTO MAX

Better overall odds of winning any prize: With these new features, the overall odds of winning any prize will be better than the previous version of LOTTO MAX. **Each play will now include four (4) selections of seven (7) numbers.**

To support these enhancements, the price of a **LOTTO MAX ticket will change from \$5 to \$6**. This small change helps us continue offering record-breaking jackpots, plus the addition of the new \$100,000 prizes to the game that Canadian lottery players love.

We're committed to keeping LOTTO MAX fresh and fun and these enhancements ensure we can keep delivering the excitement you expect.
