The Yorkton winner couldn’t believe her eyes when she saw her LOTTO 6/49 ticket was a winner and sent a screenshot to her husband, who was at work at the time.

She won her prize in the March 4 LOTTO 6/49 Classic Draw by matching all six numbers: 2, 18, 30, 39, 40, and 44. The prize was split with another winning ticket in Ontario that also matched the exact selection.
