Standing Buffalo local wins \$500K on LOTTO MAX!

REGINA (February 11, 2026) — Michael Redman won \$500,000 on LOTTO MAX.

The Standing Buffalo local said he was having a slower holiday morning when he discovered the win.

“I was sitting around doing nothing, so I decided to check the ticket on the [Lotto Spot] app,” he said. “I couldn’t believe it!”

Redman called his family to tell them right away.

Now, Redman intends to put his windfall to good use: “I have two daughters, so this will benefit them,” he explained. “And I’m going to pay off my SUV... the rest is up in the air right now.”

He won his prize on the December 26 LOTTO MAX draw by matching a MAXMILLIONS selection: 7, 12, 16, 17, 18, 37 and 47. Another winning ticket matching the same selection was purchased in Ontario and the two winners split the \$1 million prize.
