

THE BIG SPIN Event Game Conditions

RULES AND REGULATIONS:

1. “THE BIG SPIN Event” (the “Final Event”) is governed by the Rules and Regulations Respecting Lotteries and Gaming (The “General Rules”) of WESTERN CANADA LOTTERY CORPORATION (WCLC) WHICH INCLUDE LIMITATIONS OF LIABILITY AND ARE AVAILABLE FROM WCLC UPON REQUEST and these Game Conditions.
2. These Game Conditions (hereinafter referred to as the “Rules”) apply to the Final Event (s) related to all \$5 “THE BIG \$PIN” instant ticket game(s) that are conducted and managed by WCLC. Unless otherwise noted, these Rules operate as separate and distinct from any conditions contained on any “THE BIG \$PIN” Instant tickets.
3. Words used in these Rules which are used in the General Rules shall have the same meaning as those used in the General Rules. In the event of any conflict or inconsistency between these Rules and the General Rules, the General Rules shall govern.

ELIGIBILITY TO PARTICIPATE

4. In order to participate in the Final Event and/or be eligible to receive all or part of a Prize (as herein defined in Rule 12) (personally or as a member of a group), a player must:
 - (a) be the holder lawfully entitled to possession of a winning \$5 “THE BIG \$PIN” instant ticket that qualifies such holder to participate in the Final Event pursuant to the play instructions for such ticket;
 - (b) prior to participating in the Final Event, have participated in good faith in any investigation conducted by WCLC and satisfied WCLC that they are the holder lawfully entitled to possession of the \$5 “THE BIG \$PIN” Instant ticket and are entitled, and will remain entitled, to any Prize;
 - (c) have initiated the prize claim prior to the expiry date for prize claims for the relevant \$5 “THE BIG \$PIN” Instant ticket referenced in Rule 4(a); and
 - (d) have otherwise complied with the General Rules in all other respects.

FINAL EVENT PARTICIPATION

5. A player may participate in the Final Event in one of three (3) ways, as outlined in Rules 6 to 8.
6. **Spin-** Subject to Rules 7 and 8 a player may elect to participate using the Spin method. When participating using this method:
 - (a) A player will be provided three (3) chances to complete a single valid Spin. A valid Spin consists of at least three (3) full three-hundred and sixty degree (360°) rotations of The Big Spin Wheel (the “Wheel”) in a downward direction, as determined by WCLC. After the player has completed their first valid Spin, he/she will not be provided any more chances to Spin. Any Spin that is not a valid Spin is deemed to be void and shall not result in any entitlement to a Prize;

- (b) the start position of the Wheel for a Spin will be determined by an electronic draw. WCLC will conduct an electronic draw using its certified digital drawing equipment prior to the Spin Event. The draw parameters will be set to draw 3 numbers at random from among all numbers from 1 to 20 to determine the start position of the Wheel for each Spin in accordance with Rule 14. The first number drawn will signify the starting sector position of the Wheel for the first Spin attempt, the second number will signify the starting sector position of the Wheel for the second Spin attempt, where required, and the third number will signify the starting sector position of the third Spin attempt, where required. The Wheel has sector numbers clearly labeled from 1 to 20 so for example if the first number drawn is 4 then the starting position of the Wheel for the first Spin attempt would be sector 4 which is a value of \$125,000;
- (c) the Prize to which the player is entitled shall be determined by the final resting place of the Wheel at the end of the first valid Spin. The Wheel is deemed to have reached the final resting place when it comes to a complete stop and WCLC declares the Spin complete. If for any reason the Wheel moves after WCLC has declared the Spin complete, the position of the Wheel at the time WCLC declared the Spin to be complete shall be deemed as the final resting place of the Wheel; and
- (d) in the event a player does not complete a valid Spin after three (3) attempts, the Envelope Draw method shall be used to determine a player's entitlement to a Prize.

7. **Envelope Draw-** Subject to Rule 8, if a player is unable to participate using the Spin method for reasons of disability or infirmity he/she may elect to have his/her final Prize determined by Envelope Draw, or a player may be required to proceed with the Envelope Draw method pursuant to Rule 6(d), or a Group may elect to proceed with an Envelope Draw in accordance with Rule 11. When participating using this method:
- (a) an Envelope Draw will be used to determine the player's entitlement to a Prize;
 - (b) the Envelope Draw will consist of WCLC placing each of the numbers from 1 to 20 representing the Prize denominations in accordance with Rule 14 in 20 separate unmarked envelopes. The player may request to see the numbers representing the Prize denominations in accordance with Rule 14 prior to WCLC placing them in the envelopes. Once the numbers are placed in the envelopes, WCLC will place envelopes in a draw box, randomly mix the envelopes and then the player shall select one envelope from the draw box; and
 - (c) the number in the envelope selected by the player shall determine the player's entitlement to a Prize in accordance with Rule 14. For example, if the number in the envelope selected by the player is 8, the player is entitled to a \$200,000 Prize.

8. **Default Win- If:**
- (a) a player is unable or unwilling to designate a Proxy, within the time specified by WCLC for doing so;
 - (b) a player is unable or unwilling to attend the Final Event at the location and time specified by WCLC;
 - (c) a Group has elected to participate by means of a Default Win;
 - (d) a Group fails to make an election under Rule 11 within the time specified by WCLC for doing so; and/or
 - (e) a player or any member of a Group has not attained the age of 18 years of age or older,

WCLC shall award the lowest Prize denomination as outlined in Rule 12 and there shall be no right to any other Prize with respect to the Final Event.

9. **Proxy-** Subject to WCLC’s approval, if a player or Group Designate is unable to participate using the Spin method for reasons of disability or infirmity, or if he/she is unable or unwilling to attend the Spin or Envelope Draw event at the location and time specified by WCLC, the player or the Group may make a written election to have a Proxy to act on his/her/their behalf. A Proxy:
- (a) shall have no entitlement to any Prize resulting from the Final Event and may be required to execute a release indicating the same prior to participation in the Final Event;
 - (b) will participate in a Spin or Envelope Draw in the place of the designator(s), and the result of such Spin shall be final and binding on the designator(s) of the Proxy; and

The Proxy may not exercise the election to participate through the Envelope Draw method, and such election may only be made by the designator. A Proxy must be 18 years of age or older, and must not be an employee of WCLC or a Provincial Organization.

10. The Envelope Draw and/or Spin(s) will take place at a location, date and time designated by WCLC. Subject to Rule 9, in order to participate through the Envelope Draw or Spin method, the player or Proxy must attend.

GROUP PLAY

11. If the holder lawfully entitled to possession of a “THE BIG \$PIN” Instant ticket that meets the requirement contained in Rule 4 is more than one individual (a “Group”), the members of the Group shall either:
- (a) select a single representative to participate in a Spin or Envelope Draw (a “Designate”). Once selected the Designate may not be changed; or
 - (b) elect to participate through a Default Win; and

Each member of the Group is deemed to represent and warrant to WCLC that there are no additional members of the Group that may make a claim to entitlement to a Prize and all members of the Group must, prior to participating in the Final Event, execute a release confirming the selection of a Designate and/or their election and that the result of such Designate’s Spin or Envelope Draw or the Default Win shall be final and binding on all members of the Group.

PRIZE STRUCTURE AND ODDS OF WINNING

12. The following prizes are available to be won and the odds of winning each prize are as follows (each a “Prize” and collectively “Prizes”);

\$100,000 (CAD)	1 in 10
\$125,000 (CAD)	1 in 10
\$150,000 (CAD)	1 in 10
\$175,000 (CAD)	1 in 10
\$200,000 (CAD)	1 in 10
\$225,000 (CAD)	1 in 10
\$250,000 (CAD)	1 in 10
\$275,000 (CAD)	1 in 20
\$300,000 (CAD)	1 in 20
\$350,000 (CAD)	1 in 20
\$400,000 (CAD)	1 in 20
\$500,000 (CAD)	1 in 10

13. For the avoidance of doubt, the odds of winning refer only to odds of winning each Prize in a Spin or Envelope Draw of the Final Event, and do not refer to the odds of winning any prize on any “THE BIG \$PIN” Instant tickets.

STARTING POSITION FOR THE WHEEL AND ENVELOPE DRAW PRIZES

14. For the purpose of determining the starting position of the Wheel in accordance with Rule 6 and determining entitlement to a Prize using the Envelope Draw method, the numbers used in the electronic draw and the Envelope Draw shall correspond to the Wheel Starting Positions/Prize Denominations as follows:

MISCELLANEOUS

15. If for any reason WCLC determines that the electronic draw mechanism referenced in Rule 6 or the Wheel has malfunctioned or is likely to malfunction due to a technical failure, ambiguous Spin result, or otherwise, WCLC may either (i) declare any Spin or electronic draw void and require the player or Proxy to participate via Envelope Draw; or (ii) postpone the completion of an electronic draw or Spin until such time as it determines that the electronic draw mechanism and Wheel have been restored to proper functioning order.
16. Any election by a player or Group as referenced in these Rules shall be in writing in a form prescribed by WCLC.
17. Prior to participating in the Final Event by the Spin or Envelope Draw method the participant must execute a waiver release in favour of WCLC in writing in a form prescribed by WCLC.
18. WCLC may amend these Rules at any time and in any manner.
19. The headings in these Rules are for convenience of reference only and do not affect the interpretation of these Rules.
20. All draws will adhere to the draw procedures established for the draw by WCLC.
21. The terms “Proxy”, “player”, “Group”, and “Designate” are interchangeable as context requires.
